Background

Syrian NGOs (SNGOs) were established in response to the need for humanitarian assistance inside Syria and also meet the needs of Refugees in neighboring countries post March 2011. Some SNGOs felt the need for a body where common advocacy messages relating to humanitarian issues are being agreed. Syrian NGO Alliance (SNA) saw the light on the 2nd April 2014 in Gaziantep, Turkey.

SNA consists of 22 SNGOs who are some of the largest SNGOs working to meet the Humanitarian needs in line with international standards and protocols. SNA provides the umbrella for these SNGOs to coordinate and advocate common messages ensuring the voices of affected populations heard. Syrian NGO Alliance (SNA) Advocacy Activities

SNA participates and attends several periodic and scheduled meetings through SNA secretariats team or SNA NGO-members, including HLG, ICCG, SSG, ICVA, SCSP, NGO Forum GA meeting, PAWG meeting of SIRF, and SCNP following up on updated contexts that support the mandate of the SNA, providing updates on the context, funding, access, coordination, joint planning, Emergency Planning, Contingency Planning, the main gaps and challenges as well as the access challenges, along with products to be worked on while helping stakeholders better understand SNGOs' perspectives on the current situation and priorities.

On June 6th, SNA hosted GA monthly meeting in person at Ihsan org office and online via zoom. Where 21 out of 25 NGO-members attended the meeting. Main agenda was around SNA Story and the future vision of the alliance's role in the humanitarian response. Where a prepared file was presented during the meeting, and a new committee was formed to develop a new vision consisting of GA memb

On June 13th, SNA attended PAWG meeting hosted by SIRF, discussion included the following: updates from last SSG meeting, Early recovery strategy and trust fund, advocacy actions toward the XB modality.

On June 13th, SNA attended a meeting with Ms Severine Rey, Director of OCHA MENA Regional office, in the presence of SNL and SSG members, discussion focused on reviewing the latest updates on Early recovery strategy and SNGO concerns around the strategy.

On June 14th, SNA and NWS NGO Forum disseminated the report on challenges of issuing work permits, the report was a result of inputs from 36 NGO-members of SNA and the forum. The report included the most important info about participating organizations in the questionnaire, current situation and main factors affecting work permits, in addition to recommendations, and explanation of effect of the delay in approval or refusal to obtain work permit on humanitarian works.

On June 13th and 27th, SNA attended ADWG hosted by NWS NGO Forum, which discussed the following: updates around HOV conference, Donors pledges post B8C, Fund reduction challenges, XB modality, Work permit issuing challenges, in addition to introducing the new NWS NGOO forum director.
