Background

Syrian NGOs (SNGOs) were established in response to the need for humanitarian assistance inside Syria and also meet the needs of Refugees in neighboring countries post March 2011. Some SNGOs felt the need for a body where common advocacy messages relating to humanitarian issues are being agreed. Syrian NGO Alliance (SNA) saw the light on the 2nd April 2014 in Gaziantep, Turkey.

SNA consists of 25 SNGOs who are some of the largest SNGOs working to meet the Humanitarian needs in line with international standards and protocols. SNA provides the umbrella for these SNGOs to coordinate and advocate common messages ensuring the voices of affected populations heard. Syrian NGO Alliance (SNA) Advocacy Activities

SNA participates and attends several periodic and scheduled meetings through SNA secretariats team or SNA NGO-members, including HLG, ICCG, SSG, ICVA, SCSP, NGO Forum GA meeting, PAWG meeting of SIRF, and SCNP following up on updated contexts that support the mandate of the SNA, providing updates on the context, funding, access, coordination, joint planning, Emergency Planning, Contingency Planning, the main gaps and challenges as well as the access challenges, along with products to be worked on while helping stakeholders better understand SNGOs' perspectives on the current situation and priorities.

SNA attended the "Hear Our Voices" conference in Amman through representatives from the SNA Steering Committee. SNA participated in a presentation as an advocacy product aimed at highlighting the pledges of the 7th and 8th Brussels Conference, with the purpose of advocating for focused and appropriate distribution of funding for Syria and neighboring countries.

SNA attended the monthly meeting of the Syrian Civil Networks Platform (SCNP). The meeting addressed the preparations for the platform's conference planned to be held in Denmark on Oct 2024, the agenda of the conference still under discussion, mainly the conference will focus on the future of SCNP and the related networks and the current challenges.

SNA attended a meeting hosted by the NWS NGO Forum, where the main priorities to be highlighted before the Regional Humanitarian Coordinator (RHC) were discussed for presentation at the general assembly meeting of the NWS NGO Forum.

SNA participated in a webinar on the experience of localization in Palestine, organized by the "Near" network. Several important aspects were highlighted, notably the gradual shift of endowment projects away from reliance on private institutional budgets. The discussion also pointed out the differences between the Palestinian and Syrian experiences, where Palestinian organizations operate from within Palestine due to recognized licenses and official money transfer mechanisms, while Syrian organizations face challenges related to operating in the diaspora and the absence of such facilitation.

News related to the Syrian Humanitarian Affairs . September 2024

BACKGROUND

The 2023 February earthquakes evidenced the need to review and adjust the Protection Cluster strategy, considering that the protracted crisis in northwest Syria gained an additional layer of complexity as a result of the natural disaster. After 4 months of response (February-May), we were able to understand that 49% of the after-EQ response was done through awareness raising and information dissemination, compared to 46% done through the provision of protection services. This analysis, added to already ongoing discussions around the proposals received for the different pooled funds and further emphasized the need to update and tailor the protection response to current needs on the ground, understanding the multitude of factors in existence as well as the necessity to increase the technical and operational capacity from partners.

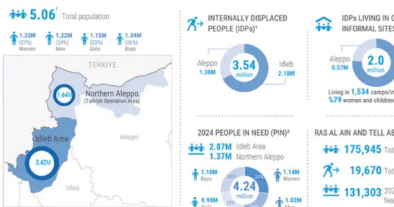

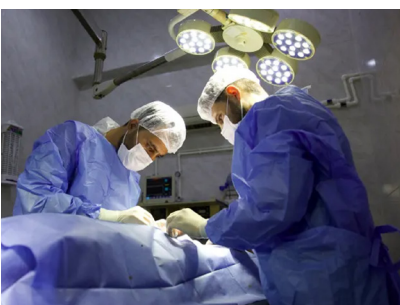
POPULATION OVERVIEW IN NORTHWEST SYRIA (NWS)
