➤ BACKGROUND:

Syrian NGOs (SNGOs) were established in response to the need for humanitarian assistance inside Syria and also meet the needs of Refugees in neighboring countries post March 2011. Some SNGOs felt the need for a body where common advocacy messages relating to humanitarian issues are being agreed. Syrian NGO Alliance (SNA) saw the light on the 2nd April 2014 in Gaziantep, Turkey.

➤ WHO ARE WE?

SNA consists of **22 SNGOs** who are some of the largest SNGOs working to meet the Humanitarian needs in line with international standards and protocols. SNA provides the umbrella for these SNGOs to coordinate and advocate common messages ensuring the voices of affected populations heard. We play an active role when it comes to how aid is being delivered in Syria.

➤ SYRIAN NGO ALLIANCE (SNA) ADVOCACY ACTIVITIES:

October 14: SNA participated in an experience-sharing meeting with the Steering Committee members of the Iraq NGO Network, organized by ICVA. During the meeting, a comprehensive introductory file about the Alliance was presented, covering its structure and objectives, areas of work and strategies, quarterly reports, challenges faced, as well as planned future activities and initiatives. The file aims to enhance a shared understanding of SNA's role and experiences, and to facilitate the exchange of knowledge and best practices among civil society networks in the region.

October 15: SNA participated in the NNGO Chamber meeting to discuss the challenges facing NGOs in Syria, particularly regarding current laws and regulations, funding and reporting mechanisms, and organizational independence. The meeting addressed difficulties in implementing an outdated law from the 1950s, challenges related to domestic and international funding, and interference in organizational media content, with a focus on the situation in northeast Syria and procedures for handling financial transfers and local suppliers. Participants proposed several solutions and advocacy measures, including reviewing and amending the law, strengthening communication channels with governmental bodies, unifying the voice and documenting challenges, and defining the National NGO Chamber's priorities regarding legal frameworks, internal cohesion, localization, and fair distribution of funding. Updates on SNGOF's work, recruitment, team-building, collaborations, and partnerships were also shared, emphasizing the importance of joint work and proper relationship-building with governmental authorities to ensure a conducive working environment for humanitarian organizations in Syria.

October 22: SNA held a meeting with finance representatives of member organizations to discuss financial and banking challenges in Syria amid changing laws and governmental procedures. The meeting reviewed the banking landscape, difficulties in opening accounts, and intra-governorate fund transfers, in addition to financial transfer mechanisms from Turkey, and discussed solutions for dealing with local suppliers and setting unified templates for documenting transfers and payments. Attendees also reviewed legal accounting books and financial records, internal grant and financial reporting supervision, compliance with new tax and employee registration laws, and the procedure for contracting a certified accountant to regularly update financial reports. The meeting concluded with an agreement to continue coordination among organizations, prepare a unified internal guide, and hold a follow-up meeting next month to review updates in tax laws and transfer procedures.

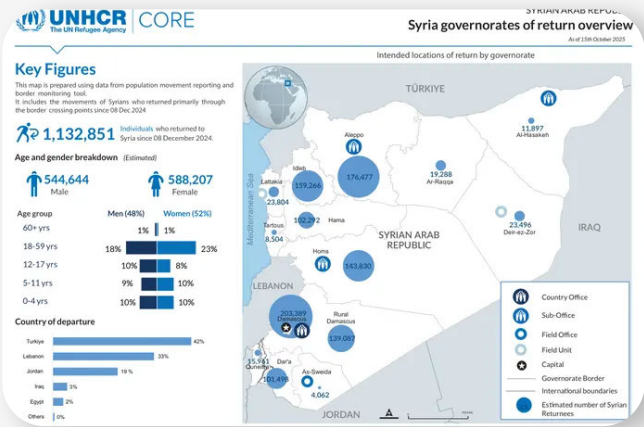
